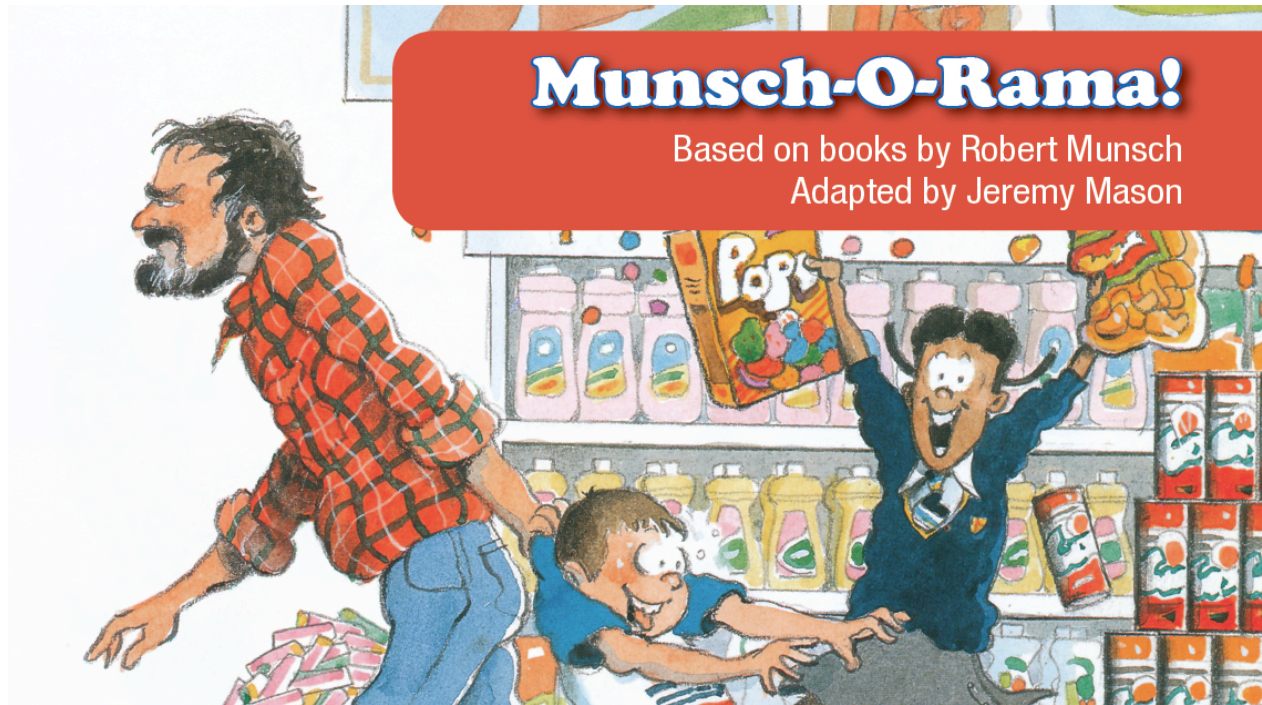

## BOOKING AND TECHNICAL INFORMATION

### **Tour Dates – Lethbridge & Area**

Monday, January 6/14 – Friday, January 10/14

### **School – One Performance Fee:**

\$600.00 + \$30.00 GST = \$630.00

### **Community Performance Fee:**

\$1000.00 + \$50.00 GST = \$1050.00

**Payment:** 50% is due upon contract signing. Balance is due on the day of the performance, prior to the performance time.

**Maximum audience size:** 300

**Playing area:** 30' x 20'

**Touring Company:** Maximum 4 actors and 1 stage manager

**Dressing Rooms:** 2 rooms are required in close proximity to the performance area and washrooms

**Touring Company will arrive approximately 1.5 hours prior to the performance time**

**Length of Performance (including optional question and answer period):** 1 hour – 1 hour 10 minutes. ***Please note:*** It will take 30-45 minutes to strike the show after the performance is over.

**Volunteers:** 4-6 people are required to assist with the unloading and loading

**Parking:** Sufficient parking for a panel van and a passenger van.

**Technical Requirements:** 2 – 120V AC circuits within 50' of playing area.
